ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

Advised that he received complaints about a bus stop on Main Ave and Alden. Spoke to Ray Dynes and there is work that needs to be done with NJ Transit. Councilwoman Dabal asked about cost benefit of different bus stop locations. Borough Administrator explained that there are different bus routes. Spoke about how the copy machine contract is up for renewal and price impacts. Advised that we look to receive upgrades while lowering cost by about \$25.00 per month. Notified that a new stop sign will be installed at Wallington Ave and Union and prior to its installation residents will be notified. Advised the removal of 10 vehicles from our insurance and discussed JIF.

Engineers Report:

David Juzmeski Boro Engineer Provided summary insight into the following projects: 2020 Municipal Aid, Union Boulevard project, Generator Project Fire department Roof Replacement, Mt. Pleasant Park, 54 Union Boulevard, stop sign process, water main, Willow Ave project, televising of sewer main in the area or Reservoir Ave, State Department of Environmental Protection storm water plan, 2019 road Program, Bergen Councilman Brunacki brought up issues with lights and Country and Morrissee. protruding bolts at the Mt. Pleasant Park. Councilman Androwis brought up safety issues that were brought up as well with Mt. Pleasant Park: Borough Engineer advised that these Councilwoman President Dabal asked about many issues will be taken care of. deficiencies with curbing and sidewalk as well as what the established time line is to address these issues. Borough Engineer would investigate, but advised that some projects are still not closed out. Councilman Androwis asked about Midland and Main. Borough Engineer outlined process, the need for an authorization for a survey, and potential issues. Borough Attorney also provided insight into legal work that would need to take place. Councilwoman President Dabal spoke about the Stormwater plan and had questions to the Borough Engineer and he subsequently explained the process and new requirements from the State.
