- 2) suggested prevention-control protocol for fall sports
 - Parents ought to check the temperature of their children before bringing them to practice. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4F is not allowed to participate in any team activity.
 - Parents should refrain from carpooling their children.
 - Parents should keep away from the field during practice.
 - Kids have to come to practice ready to play (no changing on the field).
 - Temperature screening will take place upon entry (players, refs and coaches). Anyone with a temperature over 100.4F will not be allowed to participate in any team activity.
 - Hand sanitizer must be applied before entering the field.
 - Everyone must sanitize his/her hands and equipment before each practice.
 - Whenever possible, make sure to remain six feet apart on the field.
 - Parents are not allowed on the field but can sit in the stands making sure to remain six feet apart from others.
 - Parents are asked to wear masks whenever possible.
 - All visiting teams (players and coaches) must have their temperatures checked before they are allowed on the field. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4F is not allowed to participate in a game
 - No exchange of equipment, documents, players' cards, etc is allowed.
 - Physical contact is limited whenever possible.
 - No contact greeting and celebration is allowed
