#### Presentations

- -1) Zachary Tall (aikido instructor) from Aikido Schools of NJ
  - -has been practicing aikido for twelve years
  - -has taught classes for children as young as four years old
  - -is an 8<sup>th</sup>-grade, history teacher with special-ed. certification
  - -would like children to wear a T-shirt and sweatpants to classes
- -2) Director of Summer Recreation, Charlie Vellis
  - -summer program will operate from June 28 to August 6, on weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
  - -twenty-five children per group with one counselor and one to two volunteers supervising a group
  - -there will be three buses for every field trip to account for social distancing
  - -a health director has to be hired prior to the start of the program
  - -basketball hoops need to be installed at the Little League complex
  - -registration fee should probably be raised to offset costs
  - -the registration fee will cover Powerhouse Studios event at the Little League complex
