**Garbage & Recycling must be placed curbside no earlier than
5:30 P.M. the night before
Or by 6:00 A.M. the day of your designated collection.**

WHITE GOODS, FERROUS AND NON-FERROUS METALS

Curbside pickup by appointment only on the **first Wednesday of each month.**
For appointment call 973-777-0318 ext. 202
48 hours notice is required.

NEWSPAPERS/CARDBOARD

All newspapers should be tied & bundled or placed in a container.

GLASS CONTAINERS/ALUMINUM/PLASTIC BOTTLES

Clear and colored glass jars and bottles should be rinsed thoroughly,
and all caps removed and discarded in the garbage.

***** DO NOT PLACE ANY RECYCLING IN PLASTIC BAGS *****

YARD WASTE (APRIL 1 – DECEMBER 31)

Picked up at curb every Wednesday. Branches should be tied & bundled in lengths
no more than three feet and no branches should be thicker than four inches in
diameter. Leaves will be picked up weekly. Leaves must be placed in cans or
biodegradable paper bags. Bags are available for purchase at the Civic Center.

**** RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE ONLY ****

MATTRESSES & BOXSPRINGS

Must be wrapped in plastic or they will not be picked up. Bags are available
for purchase at Civic Center

CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP

Every Wednesday from December 30th through February 7th

CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

Materials used for construction purposes will **NOT** be picked up by the garbage
contractor nor will they be accepted at the Wallington Public Works Dept.

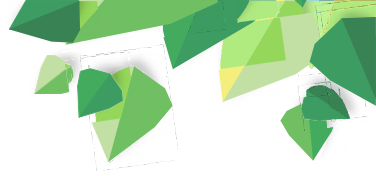

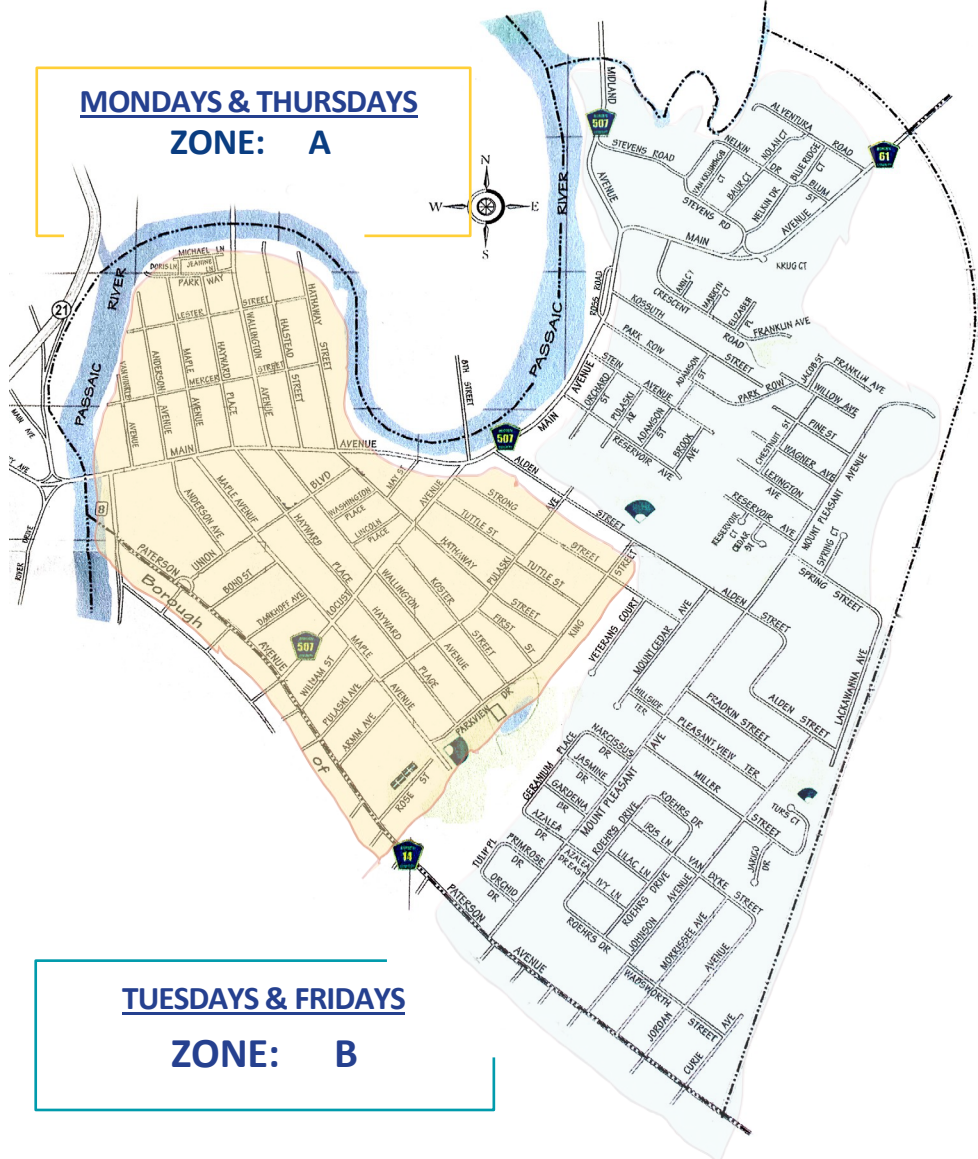
